## What is a laboratory information management system?

A laboratory information management system, or LIMS, is a kind of software that is designed to help manage large volumes of data produced from experimental workflows. In its simplest form, a LIMS acts as a tracking system that monitors the lifetime of a given sample as it progresses through various stages of production and characterization.
