BioPACIFIC MIP, located jointly at the University of California, Los Angeles and University of California, Santa Barbara, is a platform dedicated to scalable production of bio-derived building blocks and polymers from yeast, fungi and bacteria. In these facilities automated high-throughput synthesis and characterization of bio-derived polymers aims to accelerate discovery and speed development of new high-performance materials.

The synthesis and characterization laboratory at UC Santa Barbara is located in **2411 Elings** and the additive manufacturing laboratory is located in **2436B Elings**.

The Living BioFoundry and Micro ED facilities are located at UCLA.
