

# BioPACIFIC MIP

BioPACIFIC MIP, located jointly at the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) and University of California, Santa Barbara (UCSB), is a platform dedicated to scalable production of bio-derived building blocks and polymers from yeast, fungi and bacteria. In these facilities, automated high-throughput synthesis and characterization of bio-derived polymers aim to accelerate discovery and speed up the development of new high-performance materials.

The synthesis and characterization laboratory at UCSB is located in **2411 Elings** and the additive manufacturing laboratory is located in **2436B Elings**.

The Living BioFoundry and Micro ED facilities are located at UCLA (CNSI Building).
